13) FUTURE AGENDA ITEMS

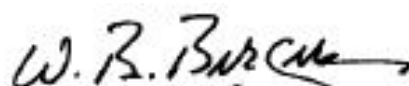
There were no items brought forward for inclusion in future agendas.
