 - ii. City's Independence Day Celebration: Will occur at Los Nietos Park on July 3rd. Volunteers will assist with community games and trash pick-up.

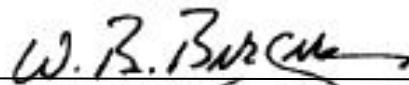
7) OLD BUSINESS – EXECUTIVE SECRETARY WAYNE B. BERGERON
