



City of Santa Fe Springs Zoning Code *Update*

The Community Development Department is leading a comprehensive update of the City's Zoning Code Update to modernize land use regulations. This ongoing initiative plays a key role in shaping how our community grows and evolves in the years ahead.

The City held its first public workshop for the Zoning Code Update on Tuesday, June 10, 2025. The workshop saw a diverse and enthusiastic group of participants, including City Council members, Planning Commissioners, City staff, the Chamber of Commerce, local business owners, real estate brokers, and residents. Organized in partnership with the City's consultant, Lisa Wise Consulting, and the Community Development Department, the session introduced the goals, timeline, and scope of the project.

This workshop was just the beginning. The City encourages all residents and stakeholders to stay engaged and informed as the project moves forward. Public Workshop #2 is on the horizon, and your input remains vital. In future workshops, the City and its consultant will provide an assessment of stakeholder comments, discuss recommendations, and comment on future drafts of the new Zoning Code.

CLEAR THE CORNERS: CALIFORNIA'S NEW DAYLIGHTING LAW (AB 413)



ASSEMBLY BILL 413 PROHIBITS PARKING WITHIN 20 FEET OF ANY MARKED OR UNMARKED CROSSWALK, AND WITHIN 15 FEET OF CROSSWALKS WITH CURB EXTENSIONS. THIS APPLIES TO ALL INTERSECTIONS STATEWIDE, REGARDLESS THE LAW WAS CREATED TO IMPROVE PEDESTRIAN SAFETY BY REDUCING COLLISIONS AND INCREASE VISIBILITY FOR PEDESTRIANS AND MOVING VEHICLES. VIOLATING THE DAYLIGHTING LAW CAN RESULT IN A \$51 FINE.

- ON TWO-WAY STREETS: DO NOT PARK WITHIN 20 FEET OF THE APPROACH SIDE OF ANY CROSSWALK.
- ON ONE-WAY STREETS: DO NOT PARK WITHIN 20 FEET OF THE APPROACH SIDE OF ANY CROSSWALK ON EITHER SIDE OF THE STREET.
- . CURB EXTENSIONS: MAINTAIN AT LEAST 15
- FEET OF CLEARANCE. . UNMARKED CROSSWALKS: THE LAW APPLIES EVEN IF THE CROSSWALK IS NOT
