

RV PERMIT PROGRAM

Attention Santa Fe Springs residents and recreational vehicle owners.

In order to effectively address Citywide RV parking concerns, the City Council established a RV Parking Permit Program to authorize and regulate RV parking on City streets by temporary permit. The new RV parking restriction is effective on March 28, 2025, with a one-month educational and warning period prior to enforcement, that starts on April 28, 2025. RV Permits can be obtained by visiting the Police Services Center located at 11576 Telegraph Rd.

To apply for an RV permit, provide the following:

Resident Information:

- Name, residential address, and phone number of the applicant or host resident.
- Proof of residency (e.g., driver's license, ID card, property tax bill, or utility bill).

RV Owner Information:

- Name, address, and phone number of the RV's registered owner or renter.
- Copy of vehicle registration from the DMV (or equivalent state agency).
- If the applicant is not the owner/renter, a letter of authorization from the owner.

Vehicle Details:

· License number, year, make, and model of the RV.

At a glance key RV Parking Permit Rules and Regulations are*:

- Parking of Recreational Vehicles and Trailers is prohibited on City streets except by temporary permit.
- Proof of residency and vehicle registration required with application submission.
- Residents can obtain up to (3) RV permits per calendar month. Each permit is valid for up to (3) consecutive days.
- Residents can obtain an RV parking permit for an outof-town visitor, not to exceed (7) consecutive days per month or (21) days per calendar year.
- Trailers must be attached to an appropriately sized tow vehicle.
- Permitted vehicle/trailer must be parked within 100 feet of the permit holder's address listed on permit.
- Utility connections (e.g. electrical cords, water lines, etc.) may not at any time encroach upon City property/right-of-way.
- RV or trailer must comply with street sweeping and other parking requirements.
- Parking within 20 feet of any intersection is prohibited.
