Passport Services with the Santa Fe Springs Library

Gladys Magana, Administrative Assitant II with the Library & Cultural Services Division, provided a brief presentation of the Passport Services offered.

- Passport Services are offered by appointment only, Tuesday Friday from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. and you can schedule an appointment on the City website or by scanning the QR code on the flyer.
- Photography and photocopy services are available onsite.
- Passport renewal forms are available.
- Processing for first time adult applicants, 16 years old and older.
- Processing for minor applicants, 0 15 years old.
- DS-11 (first time applicants) and DS-82 (renewals) applications are available at the Library or Post Office for pick-up.
- There is a \$35 acceptance fee that is paid to the Library for the service and they accept cash, credit/debit cards, or checks.
- For the fees of the passport book or card, a check or money order are the only forms of payment accepted by the State Department.
- Processing times have shorten; for routine service, it takes 7 10 weeks and for expedited service, it takes 3 5 weeks.
- Documentation needed to apply for a passport can be found on the City Library website.
