 RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Traffic Commission:
 - 1) Approve the minutes as submitted.
- 2. REQUEST FOR PARKING RESTRICTION (BARTON CIRCLE)

RECOMMENDATION: IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE TRAFFIC COMMISSION:

1) Recommend to the City Council that parking of vehicles be prohibited nightly between the hours of 10PM and 6AM on both sides of Barton Circle between its northerly terminus at Painter Avenue and its southerly terminus at Painter Avenue.

3. REQUEST FOR PARKING RESTRICTION (LARWIN CIRCLE) RECOMMENDATION: IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE TRAFFIC COMMISSION:

1) Recommend to the City Council that parking of vehicles be prohibited nightly between the hours of 10PM and 6AM on the west side of Larwin Circle beginning 430' west of its northerly intersection with Marquardt Avenue and extending 470' southerly thereof.

Mr. Enriquez provided a brief background for items 2 and 3, emphasizing the business's concern about trailers parking long-term in front of their business and the trash they create.

After a brief discussion, Commissioner Hayes inquired about the parking spaces allotted for each business. Mr. Enriquez indicated that he would provide that information at the following meeting.

Commissioner Miranda moved to approve the consent calendar. However, without a second from the Commissioners, the Consent Calendar items were not approved.

TRAFFIC COMMISSION COMMENTS

Commissioner Gaitan asked about restriping the KEEP CLEAR sign, and the activation of the signal in front of the fire station on Telegraph Road. Mr. Enriquez will check with staff and provide an update at the next meeting.

Chairperson Carter inquired about the enforcement responsibility on Clarkman Street, where a vehicle waiting line was painted for student pick-up. He mentioned that double parking was occurring. Mr. Enriquez mentioned that during a meeting with the school district, it was decided that the schools would be responsible for enforcement. They would also encourage students/parents to use the Lake Center Park parking lot as an alternate pick-up location to reduce traffic.

Commissioner Gaitan asked about the signage at 12147 Lakeland Road, noting that vehicles tend to speed at the complex.

Commissioner Miranda commented about CHP's involvement in traffic enforcement around Charlesworth Road and the new stop signs.
