### TRAFFIC COMMISSION COMMENTS

Commissioner Gaitan commented on the right-hand turn directional at Florence and Pioneer.

Chairperson Carter inquired about the in-ground lights at Davenrich / Orr & Day Road. Traffic Engineer Kim noted that city staff is awaiting approval from the City Manager and a schedule from the Contractor. The project will start the first week of June.

Commissioner Gaitan questioned why the parking restriction request for Item 02, is for 6 AM, when they open at 7 AM. Traffic Engineer Kim noted that this was to curtail overnight and long-term parking, and is consistent with signage in the area.

Commissioner Hayes questioned if there was sufficient employee parking for the business. Traffic Engineer Kim was not aware of the number of employee parking spaces available for the location, but emphasized that the issue is for long-term parking.
