CALL TO ORDER

Chairperson Carter called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM.

PUBLIC COMMENTS ON NON-AGENDA AND AGENDA ITEMS

There was no one present for public comments, Chairperson closed Public Comments at 6:01 PM.

STAFF COMMUNICATIONS ON ITEMS OF COMMUNITY INTEREST

Public Works Director Enriquez stated there were no items of community interest to present.

2. REQUEST FOR PARKING RESTRICTION (10608 FOREST STREET)

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Traffic Commission:

- 1) Recommend to the City Council that parking of vehicles be prohibited nightly between the hours of 9 PM and 6 AM on the east side of Forest Street from its intersection with Clark Street to 215' south of the intersection.
- 2) Take such additional, related, action that may be desirable.

TRAFFIC COMMISSION COMMENTS

Commissioner Gaitan commented on the right-hand turn directional at Florence and Pioneer.

Chairperson Carter inquired about the in-ground lights at Davenrich / Orr & Day Road. Traffic Engineer Kim noted that city staff is awaiting approval from the City Manager and a schedule from the Contractor. The project will start the first week of June.

Commissioner Gaitan questioned why the parking restriction request for Item 02, is for 6 AM, when they open at 7 AM. Traffic Engineer Kim noted that this was to curtail overnight and long-term parking, and is consistent with signage in the area.

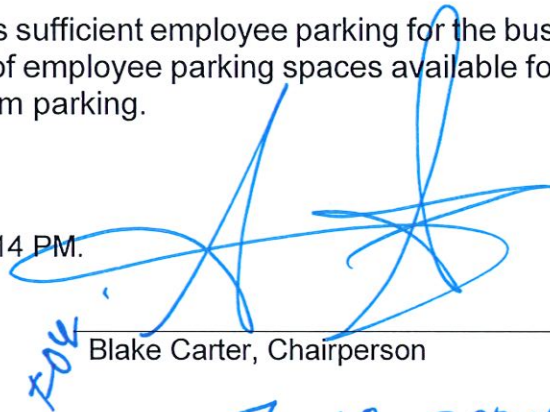
