# TRAFFIC COMMISSION COMMENTS

Vice Chair Miranda is pleased with the new stop signs installed along on Pioneer Boulevard.

Commissioner Gaitan looks forward to more commission accomplishments.

Chairperson Carter inquired about the timeline for the in-ground flashers on Davenrich Street. Traffic Engineer Kim indicated that staff has removed the flashers from Whiteland Street. However, some of the "cradles," as the base for the flashers are called broke, and staff had to order replacements. He will provide order status updates.

Public Works Director Enriquez requested clarification from Commissioner Gaitan for the sign request on Telegraph/Alburtis. Commissioner Gaitan stated that it was for a "Yield to Pedestrians" sign facing southbound traffic on Alburtis Avenue, noting that the current sign is ignored by motorists. Mr. Enriquez will have staff research signage that meets MUTC guidelines to replace the current sign.

Chairperson Carter inquired about the installation of flashing stop signs on Davenrich Street. Traffic Engineer Kim noted that installing flashing stop signs conflicts with the in-ground flashing lights per MUTC guidelines.
