TRAFFIC COMMISSION COMMENTS

Commissioner Gaitan inquired about informing and preventing residents from parking vehicles that block the sidewalk, as this forces pedestrians onto the street. Specifically, her concern is for children that walk to and from school, and provided an address. Sargent Segura indicated that they will cite the owner.

Commissioner Coca inquired about the potholes in the city, and reported a pothole in front of 10218 Flallon Avenue. Public Works Director, James Enriquez noted that staff has been working overtime to repair them with hot mix after last week's storm and in anticipation of next week's storm.

There was a brief discussion about the Yield to Pedestrian sign at Telegraph Road/Alburtis Avenue, culminating in a resolution to place the Yield to Pedestrians sign on a pole at the median.

Chairperson Carter inquired on the status of the in-ground lights for Davenrich Street. Traffic Engineer, Roy Kim indicated that the lead time to receive the product is the end of March.

Commissioner Gaitan inquired about making a dedicated right turn-only lane westbound on Florence Avenue at Pioneer Boulevard.
