## IMPORTANT INFORMATION

## Volunteer Age Requirements

- Under 14:
  - Volunteers under 14 are welcome but must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian at all times. Volunteer opportunities will be age-appropriate and limited to Community Garden Clean-ups and select special events.
- Ages 14–17:
  - Must submit a parent/guardian signed consent form and submit a current negative \*TB test.
- 18 and Older:
  - Must submit a current negative \*TB test and have a \*background check before starting.

\*TB tests and Background Checks will be provided by the City at no cost to the volunteer.

## The City offers two types of volunteer opportunities:

- One-Time Volunteers
  - Perfect for helping at a single-day event. No background check or TB test is required.
- Ongoing Volunteers
  - For those interested in volunteering regularly. Depending on your age, this option may require a background check, TB test, and orientation as part of the City's onboarding process, and in compliance with safety guidelines.

## STEPS TO BECOMING A VOLUNTEER

Step 1 - Submit an application and waiver release form.

Step 2- Pass a background check if you are over 18 years of age.

Step 3- Provide a negative TB test clearance (this applies to all Ongoing Volunteer applicants).

Step 4- Attend a brief volunteer orientation meeting. Date will be provided upon application clearance.

Step 5 - Obtain a volunteer identification card and shirt prior to volunteering.
