5. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Vice-Chairperson Aguirre moved to approve the minutes of May 18, 2022. The motion was seconded by Member Laurie Rios. Minutes were approved unanimously.

6. COUNCIL LIAISON REPORT

Mayor Annette Rodriguez announced the Summer Series Concert by No Duh, a No Doubt tribute band that took place on Friday, June 10, 2022 at Heritage Park had an exceptional turnout. She reported there have been 20 flock cameras installed throughout the City which

take pictures of license plate numbers to assist the Department of Police Services in arresting criminals in stolen vehicles passing through town. Mayor Rodriguez commented that the Safe Neighborhood Team (SNT) meetings are very informative providing information on City issues or crime statistics. She encouraged residents to attend these meetings who may have questions.

The SNT Community Block Party will be taking place on Saturday, June 25, 2022 from noon until 2:00 p.m. at Los Nietos Park. Volunteers are welcomed to assist with set-up or clean-up for the event. Members are encouraged to reach out to Lead Public Safety Officer Darryl Pedigo if they are interested in volunteering.

Mayor Rodriguez reported the Meet the Mayor at Los Nietos Park went pleasantly well and had about 90 guests attend. The Department Directors were in attendance to speak with or answer questions from residents.

7. EXECUTIVE SECRETARY REPORT

Mr. Ramirez introduced Municipal Services Manager, Kevin Periman to the committee to report on the following:

Go SFS Application Presentation – Tips for the Public

Mr. Kevin Periman, the Municipal Services Manager with the Santa Fe Springs Department of Public Works, provided a presentation on the GoSFS application. The application is a citizen engagement feature that allows residents to report any maintenance issues in the City. Reports can be made on anything, such as graffiti, pot holes, illegal dumps, etc. If you can't find the specific issue you may have on the GoSFS application, you can select 'Other' where Mr. Periman will receive the request directly. Mr. Periman shared residents have the ability to take or download photos and attach them to the report being submitted. Response times to address requests normally happen within 72 hours, including weekends. The individual making the report will also receive a text message or email stating the issue has been resolved and completed. Mr. Periman shared the Department of Public Works receives approximately 120 requests a month.

Executive Secretary Ramirez shared that Older Adult Services staff is planning to include the GoSFS application as part of a technology course which will help residents who may not be familiar or know how to utilize the application on their smart devices.

Mr. Carrillo provided a brief overview of the 2022 Summer Movie and Concert Series at Heritage Park that has begun and takes place on Fridays until August 5, 2022.
