2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

A motion was made by Kim Mette and seconded by Charlotte Zevallos to approve the Minutes of March 4, 2013. The motion was carried unanimously.

3. COUNCIL LIAISON REPORT:

- The Family & Human Services Division's Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (V.I.T.A.) Program is assisting low-income individuals and families in completing their tax returns. If you are interested please call the Gus Velasco Neighborhood Center.
- The northbound Interstate 5 Freeway Firestone exit was permanently closed beginning as of Thursday, April 4, 2013. Soon the southbound exit will also be closed.
- The lottery for the 2013 Fireworks Booths will take place this Wednesday, April 10, 2013 at 5:30 p.m. at City Hall.
- The City of Santa Fe Springs Police Services, California Highway Patrol, Whittier Police Department and the SFS Department of Fire and Rescue will conduct "Every 15 Minutes Program" at Santa Fe High School. It is a very emotional program and great to attend if you have not done so before.
- Parks & Recreation Division will be hosting Children's Day at Heritage Park this Saturday April 13, 2013 from 12:00 noon to 4:00 p.m. They will have arts & crafts, story telling, food for purchase and admission is free.

- On Wednesday, April 17, 2013, at 6:00 p.m. there will be Budget Town Hall Meeting. This meeting is to inform the public about the City budget process and listen to public concerns regarding current programs and perhaps new programs that might affect the budget. This meeting will take place at the Town Center Hall.
- First Friday at the Library on May 3, 2013 at 7:00 p.m. will feature Aconcagua. An instrumentation that captures the soul and spirit of the South American people in a program inspired by the ancient ruins and rich musical heritage of the Andean region of South America.
- The Santa Fe Springs Art Fest 2013 will take place at the Clarke Estate on Thursday, May 30, 2013 from 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. This is the first art exhibition for the City and the Heritage Art Advisory Committee. There were 130 applications received. Over 300 pieces of art will be on display.

- The Department of Fire and Rescue will be hosting an open house to celebrate a reopening of Station No.2 on Wednesday, May 8, 2013 from 11:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.
- The Santa Fe Springs Boxing Club sent two boxers along with a coach to compete in the 2013 U. S. Nationals in Spokane, Washington. This trip was paid for by funds that were raised by the boxing club

4. EXECUTIVE SECRETARY REPORT - MICHELLE SMITH

- Guest Speaker Yolanda Garcia, Art Fest, May 30, 2013. The consultant for the Santa Fe Springs Art Fest Yolanda Garcia informed the group of the upcoming Art Fest exhibition of local artists. She said that there were many great applicants and that it should be a successful art show. Artists were able to enter up to three art pieces. Approximately forty-five of these applicants were high school students. She expects a high turnout of parents and she thinks it will be a great family event.
