4. ORAL COMMUNICATIONS

5. APPROVAL OF MINUTES – JENNIFER CENTENO

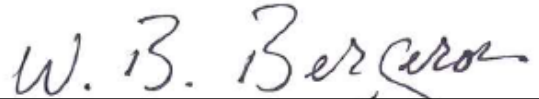
