4. Traffic Bureau Report - July 2011

There was 1 driving under the influence incident; no bicycle incidents and 1 pedestrian incident. There were 15 hit and run accidents reported. Moving Citations, Moving Violations, and Warning Notices decreased and Parking Violations increased from July 2010 compared to July 2011.

Commissioner Gaitan made a motion to receive and file the report for July 2011; Commissioner Zevallos seconded the motion which carried unanimously.
