5. Traffic Bureau Report – January 2017

Mr. Lopez reviewed the Traffic Bureau Report for the month of January 2017. The report reflects fifty collisions, which is a decrease of nineteen (19) compared to sixty nine in January 2016. There were five (5) collisions involving person driving under the influence of alcohol/drugs; one (1) pedestrian and zero (0) bicycle collisions. There

were fourteen (14) hit-and-run collisions and ten (10) collisions involving damage to city property reported. The three high collision intersections for the month were Slauson Avenue/Sorensen Avenue (2); Telegraph Road/Greenleaf Avenue (2) and Telegraph Road/Bartley Avenue (2).

Chairperson made a motion to receive and file Item 05; the motion was seconded by Vice Chair Martinez and was approved by the Traffic Commission.

6. Elements of Construction Zone Traffic Control

Mr. Lopez provided a presentation of the basic principles used to control, restrict and divert traffic safely through road construction or work zones. He also displayed photos of improper traffic control setup by contractors, Caltrans and LA County Department of Public Works.
