GOVERNOR'S EXECUTIVE ORDER N-29-20 REGARDING CORONAVIRUS COVID-19

On March 4, 2020, Governor Newsom proclaimed a State of Emergency to exist in California as a result of the threat of COVID-19. The Governor has issued Executive Orders that temporarily suspend requirements of the Brown Act, including allowing the City to hold public meetings via teleconferencing and to make public meetings accessible telephonically or otherwise electronically to all members of the public. Please be advised that, until further notice, Traffic Commission meetings will be held by teleconference. City Hall, including Council Chambers, is closed to the public.
