ALL APPLICANTS MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- 1. Must be a resident of Santa Fe Springs.
- 2. Be a senior currently attending Santa Fe High School.
- 3. Provide proof of application to or acceptance from college(s).
- 4. Include a cover letter, written by applicant, with application.
- 5. Be of good moral character, citizenship, and ethics via a letter of reference from a counselor, teacher, businessperson, or professional.
- 5. Overall GPA of 3.0
 - Must submit unofficial transcript of high school grades with application.
- 6. Involved in the following for at least two of your four years in high school: 1) High school athletics and earned a varsity letter; and 2) Have been involved with school service activities (e.g., student government, school clubs, business academy, etc.).
