CITY OF SANTA FE SPRINGS CLOSURES AND CANCELLATIONS IN RESPONSE TO CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19)

Last week, Governor Newsom and California Department of Public Health officials released an updated policy to cancel or postpone public gatherings of 250 people or more at least until the end of March. Based on this new directive designed to limit the spread of the coronavirus and out of an abundance of caution in the interest of public safety, under the direction of the City Manager, the City has decided to cancel the following City events and programs, as well as temporarily close the following City facilities until Sunday, April 19th. Please see all updates to closures and cancellations effective immediately on Monday, March 18th in blue.

Street Sweeping Services and Citations

 Scheduled street sweeping services will continue. However, citations for parking violations on scheduled street sweeping days will not be enforced. The City will reevaluate this matter on Wednesday, April 1st.
