# CITY OF SANTA FE SPRINGS CLOSURES AND CANCELLATIONS IN RESPONSE TO CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19)

This evening, due to the recent health emergency caused by the Coronavirus, the "Safer at Home" order was issued by State and County Officials. During this order, cities in Los Angeles County are advised to only leave home for essential items and avoid gatherings of over 10 people. This order will go into effect at midnight until Sunday, April 19<sup>th</sup>. For more information regarding further details of the Safer at Home order, the City urges the public to visit the following websites at <a href="https://covid19ca.gov/">https://covid19ca.gov/</a> and <a href="publichealth.lacounty.gov">publichealth.lacounty.gov</a>. Based on these new directives designed to limit the spread of the coronavirus and establish an abundance of caution in the interest of public safety, under the direction of the City Manager, the City has decided to cancel the following City events and programs until Sunday, May 31st, as well as temporarily close the following City facilities until Sunday, April 19th. However, essential services such as Police, Fire-Rescue, Infrastructure, and Transportation Services for Seniors and Person with Disabilities will still be offered. Please see all updates to closures and cancellations effective immediately in blue.

### **Street Sweeping Services and Citations**

- Scheduled street sweeping services will continue. However, citations for parking violations on scheduled street sweeping days will not be enforced. The City will reevaluate this matter on Sunday, April 19<sup>th</sup>.
- Transportation Services for seniors and persons with disabilities will still offer dial ride
  pickups, shopping trips with less than 10 people per trip as well as transportation to
  medical and dental facilities. However, all trips scheduled for 10 or more people have
