# CITY OF SANTA FE SPRINGS UPDATE ON CLOSURES AND CANCELLATIONS IN RESPONSE TO **CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19)**

The City of Santa Fe Springs is closely monitoring guidelines from federal, state and county officials regarding the coronavirus. The "Safer at Home" order remains in full effect. Based on this directive designed to limit the spread of COVID-19 and as a precaution against the virus, the City has decided to maintain facilities closed through May 2020 and cancel all programs and events through June 2020. Our city residents' health and safety remains one of our top priorities, therefore, preventing public interaction during this pandemic will reduce the exposure to COVID-19.

As a reminder, essential services such as Police, Fire-Rescue, Infrastructure, and Transportation Services for seniors and persons with disabilities are still being offered. Please see below for updates on facility closures and program and event cancellations.

- Scheduled street sweeping services will continue. However, citations for parking violations on scheduled street sweeping days will not be enforced. Citations will continue to be issued for all other violations. The City will reevaluate this matter on Friday, May 15th.
