# **UPDATE ON CLOSURES AND CANCELLATIONS IN RESPONSE TO CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19)**

The City of Santa Fe Springs continues to monitor guidelines from federal, state and county officials regarding the coronavirus. Los Angeles County has implemented a temporary new Safer at Home Health Officer Order for Control of COVID-19. New protocols have been established to prevent more cases, more serious illnesses, increased hospitalizations, and more deaths. Based on these directives designed to limit the spread of COVID-19, **the City will maintain facility closures to the public until further notice.** The reopening date of City facilities for public access is to be determined. All programs and events remain cancelled through February 2021 and some have been modified to virtual programs and activities. For more information on City events and programs, please visit the City's website. The health and safety of City residents remains one of our top priorities, therefore, preventing public interaction during this pandemic will help reduce the exposure to COVID-19.

As a reminder, essential services such as Police, Fire-Rescue, Infrastructure, and Transportation Services for seniors and persons with disabilities are still being offered. Please see below for updates on City operations.

#### City Events and Programs

- The Department of Community Services is offering a variety of virtual programs. Please refer to the Quarterly Brochure for more information.
- Santa's Christmas Float program is still running; however, it has been modified and no stops will be made.
- All Community Excursions for the winter are cancelled.
- All winter in-person sports are cancelled.
- In-person teens and in-person older adults programming are cancelled.
- In-person City events and programs remain cancelled through December 2020, including Annual Tree Lighting Ceremony, Las Posadas, Globe Portraits with Santa, Holiday Food Basket Programs, and First Friday events. ### **City Facilities**

- City facilities will remain closed to the public until **further notice**. For the complete list of these facilities, please visit the City's website.
- Tennis Courts are still open Monday-Friday, 5:00-7:00 p.m.; Saturday-Sunday, 10:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m. for singles play and by reservation only. Guidelines have been established and can be found on our website.
- City parks and playgrounds remain open; however, safety guidelines have been implemented to keep patrons safe. Park amenities such as restrooms, sports fields, basketball, handball & volleyball courts, as well horseshoe pits remain closed. Batting cages at Little Lake Park are also closed.
