CITY OF SANTA FE SPRINGS UPDATE ON CLOSURES AND CANCELLATIONS IN RESPONSE TO CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19)

The City of Santa Fe Springs continues to monitor guidelines from federal, state and county officials regarding the coronavirus. The "Safer at Home" order remains in full effect as the state and county enforce new protocols to prevent more cases, more serious illnesses, increased hospitalizations, and more deaths. Based on these directives designed to limit the spread of COVID-19, **the City will maintain facilities closed to the public until further notice.** The re-opening date of City facilities for public access is yet to be determined. All programs and events remain cancelled through October 2020 and some have been modified to virtual programs and activities. For more information on City events and programs, please visit the City's website. The health and safety of City residents remains one of our top priorities, therefore, preventing public interaction during this pandemic will help reduce the exposure to COVID-19.

As a reminder, essential services such as Police, Fire-Rescue, Infrastructure, and Transportation Services for seniors and persons with disabilities are still being offered. Please see below for updates on City operations.

The following are updates effective July 23, 2020.

Cancelled City Events and Programs

- All Community Excursions for the Fall are cancelled.
- All Summer/Fall/Winter in-person sports are cancelled.
- In person teens and in-person older adults programming are cancelled.
- In-person City events and programs remain cancelled through October 2020, including Fiestas Patrias, the Red Ribbon Parade, Halloween Haunted House & Carnival, and Dia de los Muertos. • All facility rentals will remain canceled/closed through October 2020.
