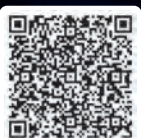

A New Era for Public Safety The Santa Fe Springs Police Department

The City of Santa Fe Springs is entering a historic new chapter with the establishment of the Santa Fe Springs Police Department (SFSPD), officially launching on March 1, 2028. This transition reflects a significant investment in local safety, service, and community-focused policing.

For more than 30 years, Santa Fe Springs has been proudly served by the Whittier Police Department—and prior to that, by the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department. The City extends its deepest appreciation to both agencies for their decades of partnership, professionalism, and dedication.

Benefits of a Local Police Department?

The creation of the SFSPD underscores the City's commitment to responsive public safety practices that are firmly rooted in community needs. Local control enables Santa Fe Springs to:

- Strengthens neighborhood relationships
- A department focused solely on Santa Fe Springs
- Advance innovation by investing in modern technology

The Road to 2028

Over the next 22 months, the City will prioritize:

- Recruitment of highly qualified officers and professional staff
- Training and technology development
- Infrastructure preparation and operational standards
- Community engagement to ensure residents remain informed and involved

Once established, the SFSPD will provide full-service public safety support, including patrol, investigation, and traffic enforcement. They will work closely with the City's Public Safety and Code Enforcement Officers to maintain a high quality of life for all who live and work in Santa Fe Springs.

Leading the Way: Police Chief Paul Espinosa

The City of Santa Fe Springs is honored to introduce Paul Espinosa as the inaugural Chief of Police. With more than 30 years of law enforcement experience, Chief Espinosa brings extensive leadership expertise and a strong commitment to community-based policing.

A Distinguished Career

Chief Espinosa began his career with the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) in 1994, rising from officer to Captain while serving in patrol, vice, narcotics, and investigations across eleven stations. His leadership roles included:

- Commanding Officer of the Foothill Patrol, Southwest, and West Valley Community Stations
- Director of In-Service Training and the Juvenile Division

Following his LAPD tenure, he served as Chief of Police for the City of Montebello, where he focused on community trust, officer development, and constitutional policing practices.

A Vision for Santa Fe Springs

As the first Chief of the SFSPD, Espinosa will oversee every aspect of the department's formation. His approach centers on professionalism, transparency, and partnership.

KEEP YOUR PETS COOL THIS SUMMER

A few simple precautions can keep your furry friends safe and comfortable all season long.

Always provide fresh water and access to shade or air conditioning, and walk during cooler morning or evening hours to avoid peak heat.

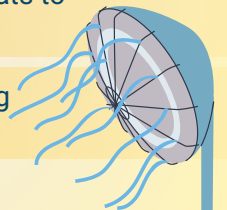
Keep pets off hot pavement, which can burn their paws.

Offer ice cubes or pet-safe frozen treats to help them cool down.

Brush regularly to prevent overheating – but avoid shaving too short.

Watch for heavy panting, drooling, or lethargy, these may signal heat stress. Seek veterinary care immediately if symptoms appear.

Dog and Cat Spay & Neuter Rebate Program



Eligible residents may qualify for up to \$350 in reimbursement when spaying or neutering their pet.

Open to Santa Fe Springs residents with a valid City pet license

Limit: 2 pets per household

Apply online at santafesprings.gov under Police Services, or submit in person or by mail. Procedures must be completed within 60 days of application. Itemized receipts dated after July 1, 2025 required. Available once every five years per household, while funds last.

HOMELESS ENGAGEMENT TEAM

If you or someone you know is experiencing homelessness or is at-risk, our team is here to help.

A dedicated Social Services Case Manager and Housing Navigator connect individuals with shelter, housing resources, and supportive services.

- **Move-In Assistance:** Security deposits, utility payments, and essential household items
- **Motel Voucher Program:** Short-term shelter for individuals transitioning into stable housing
- **Landlord Support:** Incentives for property owners who partner with the City
- **Case Management & Outreach:** Mental health resources and long-term housing solutions

SANTA FE SPRINGS CODE ENFORCEMENT

Keeping our neighborhoods safe, clean, and well-maintained is a team effort.

The Code Enforcement Team enforces the City's Municipal Code and investigates hazardous property conditions, overgrown vegetation, inoperable vehicles, unpermitted construction, and illegal land use.

When a violation is found, a Notice of Violation is issued. If unresolved, an administrative citation with a fine may follow.

RECREATIONAL VEHICLE PERMIT PROGRAM

An important reminder about RV parking in the City.

FREE PERMITS
Proof of residency
and vehicle
registration required.

Up to 3 permits per calendar year, each valid for up to 3 consecutive days

Visitor permits: Up to 7 consecutive days per month, not to exceed 21 days per year

Must park within 100 feet of permit holder's address

Must comply with street sweeping and parking regulations

Utility connections may not encroach on City property

Parking within 20 feet of an intersection is prohibited

Only "Safe & Sane" fireworks bearing the U.S. Fire Marshal seal may be sold, purchased, and discharged in the City.

Sale and discharge permitted at **June 28 at 12:00 noon** through **July 4 at 11:59 p.m.**

Fireworks prohibited on all City property, including parks.

Illegal fireworks carry fines of **\$1,000 per violation.**

Read directions carefully and never use fireworks while impaired.

Adult supervision required at all times.

Discharge only from hard surfaces, away from structures, dry vegetation, and flammable materials.

Never modify or re-light malfunctioning fireworks.

Keep a bucket of water nearby, soak used fireworks before disposal, and clean up all debris.

Keep pets indoors.

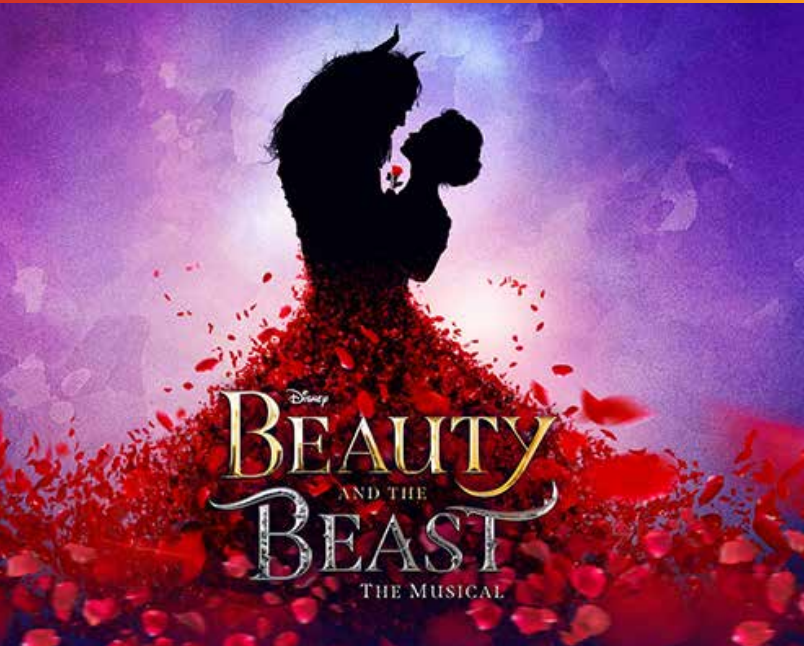

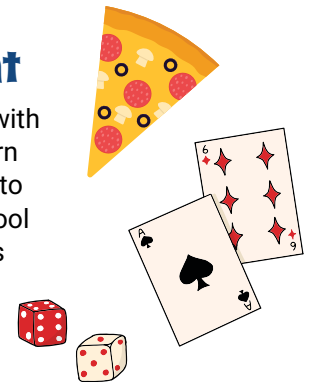

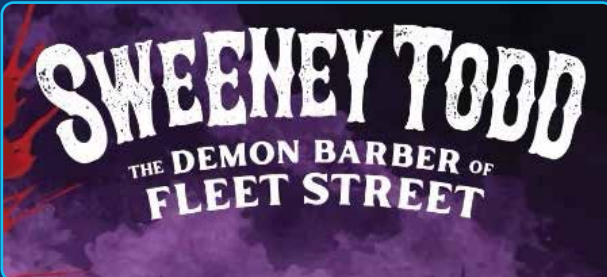
