TRESPASS ARREST

Authorization Form

To support property owners, managers, and residents in Santa Fe Springs, the Whittier Police Department accepts Trespass Arrest Authorization Letters ("Trespass Letters") to help enforce trespassing laws without the property owner or agent present.

California Senate Bill 602 (SB 602: Trespass Letters valid for 1 year occupied and vacant properties). All letters must be notarized before submission.

Home and Business Security Rebate Program

The City of Santa Fe Springs is providing security rebates of **up to \$250 for residents** and **up to \$1,500 for business owners** to help with the cost of security upgrades for their homes or non-residential/commercial properties.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Must own or rent in the City of Santa Fe Springs where the security enhancements will be installed (a valid government issued ID and utility bill required for residential applicants).

Business owners must have a valid City issued business license.

The rebate is exclusively for the cost of security enhancements such as cameras, accessories, tracking devices, alarm monitoring systems, etc. The rebate does not include installation costs.

Residents and City business owners must submit a Home & Business Security Rebate Program application.

HOUSING SUPPORT AND HOMELESSNESS RESOURCES

If you or someone you know is experiencing homelessness or at risk of becoming homeless, our Homelessness Engagement Team is here to help. A dedicated Social Services Case Manager and Housing Navigator are available to connect individuals with shelter, housing resources, and supportive services.

Services include:

- **Move-In Assistance:** Covers security deposits, utility payments, and essential household items to help individuals settle into permanent housing.
- **Motel Voucher Program:** Provides short-term shelter for individuals transitioning into stable housing.
- **Landlord Support:** Offers incentives and assistance to property owners who partner with the City to house individuals experiencing homelessness.
- **Case Management & Outreach:** Connects individuals with supportive services, mental health resources, and long-term housing solutions.

Dog and Cat Spay & Neuter Rebate Program

The City of Santa Fe Springs is providing rebates of up to \$350 for residents who spay and neuter their pets.

Qualifications:

- Must be Santa Fe Springs Resident
- Limit 2 Pets per Household
- Spay and Neuter Procedure Must be Performed within 60 Days of Application
- Itemized Receipt of Procedure Must Reflect After July 1, 2025 (While Supplies Last)
- Eligible for Rebate Once Every 5 Years Per Household
- Must have a Valid Santa Fe Springs Pet License on File
- Residents Must Submit a Dog & Cat Spay & Neuter Rebate Program Application
